The Garden Festival



Students from the International Tutoring Club at Lafayette High School have volunteered with our organization since 2012; this year was no exception! A dozen students came out to help participants upcycle bamboo and plastics into bamboo puppets, plastic water bottle flowers and a bottle cap garden sign.





In September we partnered with three non-profits to present *The Garden Festival*, the first festival of this type in Lexington.

Together with Seedleaf, The Lexington Art League and The Lexington Philharmonic, we provided a cornucopia of free musical experiences, locally grown veggies, plant-themed art projects and education on gardening and nutrition.
